2 Maryland Health Care Commission - Use of Assessed Fees - Direct Costs

- 3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that the fees assessed by the Maryland Health Care
- 4 Commission on hospitals, nursing homes, payors, and health care practitioners
- 5 shall be used exclusively to cover the actual documented direct costs of fulfilling
- 6 the Commission's statutory and regulatory duties; and generally relating to the

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Health - General

- 18 (c) (1) The total fees assessed by the Commission may not exceed \$8,250,000
- 19 in any fiscal year.
- 20 (2) The fees assessed by the Commission shall be used exclusively to
- 21 cover the actual documented direct [and indirect] costs of fulfilling the statutory and
- 22 regulatory duties of the Commission in accordance with the provisions of this subtitle.
- 23 (3) The Commission shall pay all funds collected from the fees assessed
- 24 in accordance with this section into the Fund.
- 25 (4) The fees assessed may be expended only for purposes authorized by
- 26 the provisions of this subtitle.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2000.
