12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Public Utility Companies

15 9-201.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a motor carrier permit
is required for a passenger motor vehicle used in the transportation of persons for
hire.

19 (b) A motor carrier permit is not required for:

20 (1) a motor vehicle used exclusively for the transportation of pupils to 21 and from public or private schools;

1 (2) a motor vehicle operated for a period of not more than 3 months in 2 any registration year in the transportation of persons employed at a cannery located 3 in a county;

4 (3) taxicabs;

5 (4) public transportation for hire authorized to operate on the boardwalk 6 in Ocean City;

7 (5) a vanpool operation as defined in § 11-175.1 of the Transportation 8 Article;

9 (6) the public transportation system for Washington County established 10 under § 1-603 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County, Article 22 of 11 the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland; [or]

12 (7) the public transportation system for Allegany County established 13 under § 23-24 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany County, Article 1 of the 14 Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland; OR

(8) THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM FOR FREDERICK COUNTY
 ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR FREDERICK
 COUNTY.

18 (c) The public duties of a common carrier may not be imposed on a person

19 with respect to a vehicle for which a motor carrier permit is required under this

20 section, if the vehicle is not actually engaged in public transportation.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2000.
