SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

15(g)(1)The Sheriff of Caroline County shall receive an annual salary of16[\$45,000 in 1995 and in each subsequent year] \$49,500.

17 (2) The Sheriff may appoint deputy sheriffs and other personnel in 18 accordance with the County budget.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, 20 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or 21 apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Caroline County in office on the 22 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or

23 compensation of the Sheriff of Caroline County shall take effect at the beginning of

24 the next following term of office.

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2002.
