1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Renewal**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in St. Mary's County the renewal of alcoholic
4 beverages licenses under certain conditions; setting a certain term and
5 expiration date for licenses; authorizing a holder of an expired license to apply
6 for a new license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in St.
7 Mary's County.

9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

12 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 10-301.

17 (R) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY.

18 (2) UNLESS AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A
19 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE
20 FIRST APRIL 30 THAT COMES AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.

HOUSE BILL 453

1 (3) BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE MAY RENEW IT FOR AN
2 ADDITIONAL TERM IF THE LICENSEE APPLIES FOR RENEWAL TO THE
3 ADMINISTRATOR OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BOARD OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY
4 FROM FEBRUARY 1 THROUGH MARCH 3, BOTH INCLUSIVE.

5 (4) A HOLDER OF AN EXPIRED LICENSE MAY APPLY TO THE BOARD FOR
6 A NEW LICENSE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2000.
