2 **Queen Anne's County - County Commissioners - Express Powers**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a provision of law excepting Queen Anne's County from
4 the grant of certain express powers to county commissioners; and generally
5 relating to the express powers granted Queen Anne's County Commissioners.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Article 25 - County Commissioners
8 Section 3(a)
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 25 - County Commissioners**

15 (a) (1) The county commissioners of each county in this State, in addition to,
16 but not in substitution of, the powers which have been or may be granted them, have
17 the following express powers.

18 (2) (i) The following counties are excepted from these express powers.

19 (ii) Anne Arundel County; included, however, in subsections (t)(3)
20 and (t-1);

- 1 (iii) Baltimore County; included, however, in subsection (t)(3);
- 2 (iv) Cecil County; included, however, in subsections (l), (s-1), and
3 (t)(3) and (t-1);
- 4 (v) Howard County; included, however, in subsections (t)(3) and
5 (t-1);
- 6 (vi) Prince George's County; included, however, in subsection (t)(3)
7 and in subsection (t-1) except to the extent that an area is under the WSSC; AND
- 8 (vii) [Queen Anne's County; included, however, in subsections (f),
9 (s)(3), (s-1), (t)(3), (t-1) and (ii);
- 10 (viii)] Worcester County; included, however, in subsections (l),
11 (s)(2), (t)(3), (t-1), (x), (x-1), (x-2), and (y).

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2000.
