1 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 2 appointed and qualifies.

3 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 4 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2000.
