- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 1
- 2 July 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 10 years and, at the end of June
 3 30, 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
 4 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
