2 **Charles County - Possession and Consumption of Alcohol - Regulation**

3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions of law authorizing certain counties to regulate
4 the possession and consumption of alcohol under certain circumstances to
5 include Charles County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 19-103.

15 (a) The subdivisions enumerated in this subsection may adopt ordinances or
16 resolutions supplementing this subheading. This includes the authority to regulate
17 possession or consumption of any alcoholic beverage on any public property, property
18 used by the public in general, or on any highway:

19 (1) Anne Arundel County;

20 (2) Baltimore City;

21 (3) Baltimore County;

22 (4) Harford County;

23 (5) Prince George's County;

24 (6) St. Mary's County;

- 1 (7) Cecil County;
- 2 (8) Garrett County; [and]
- 3 (9) Frederick County; AND
- 4 (10) CHARLES COUNTY.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2000.
