## 3 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of judges authorized for Circuits 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, and 8 (Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Montgomery, Prince George's, and Worcester counties and Baltimore City); increasing the number of associate judges of the District Court in District 4 and providing for the effective date of this Act. 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 1-503(a)(2), (3), (15), (16), and (23) and (b) and 1-603(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement) 12 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 1-602 Annotated Code of Maryland (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement) SECTION 1.
