3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain unanticipated 4 lottery revenues to all the public school systems in the State; requiring that 5 public school systems use the money that is distributed only for certain 6 purposes; specifying that the money distributed under this Act is intended to 7 provide additional revenue for public school systems and may not supplant any 8 other appropriation to public school systems; defining certain terms; and 9 generally relating to the distribution of lottery proceeds to public school systems 10 in the State.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:
