By agreement of the parties or by order of court, the following expenses 18 19 incurred on behalf of a child may be divided between the parents in proportion to their adjusted actual incomes: 21 any expenses for attending a special or private elementary or (1) 22 secondary school to meet the particular educational needs of the child; [or] ANY EXPENSES FOR TUTORING SERVICES TO MEET THE 23 24 PARTICULAR EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF THE CHILD; AND ANY EXPENSES FOR PARTICIPATION IN A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE 25 (III)26 GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM TO MEET THE PARTICULAR EDUCATIONAL NEEDS
