SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District

- 2 1-107.
- 3 THE WSSC MAY NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST A PERSON ON THE BASIS OF SEX,
- 4 RACE, CREED, COLOR, AGE, MENTAL OR PHYSICAL HANDICAP, SEXUAL ORIENTATION,
- 5 OR NATIONAL ORIGIN.
- 6 3-102.
- 7 (b) This section only applies to design/build contracts and construction
- 8 contracts.
- 9 (H) (1) THE WSSC MAY NOT AWARD A CONTRACT TO A CONTRACTOR UNLESS
- 10 THE CONTRACT CONTAINS PROVISIONS OBLIGATING THE CONTRACTOR:
- 11 (I) NOT TO DISCRIMINATE IN ANY MANNER AGAINST AN
- 12 EMPLOYEE OR AN APPLICANT FOR EMPLOYMENT ON THE BASIS OF SEX, RACE,
- 13 CREED, COLOR, AGE, MENTAL OR PHYSICAL HANDICAP, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, OR
- 14 NATIONAL ORIGIN; AND
- 15 (II) TO INCLUDE A SIMILAR NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE IN ALL
- 16 SUBCONTRACTS.
- 17 (2) (I) IF THE NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE IS OMITTED FROM A
- 18 CONTRACT OR SUBCONTRACT THE WSSC SHALL PROVIDE A REASONABLE
- 19 OPPORTUNITY TO CURE THE DEFECT, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 20 SUBSECTION.
- 21 (II) IF THE CONTRACTOR FAILS TO CURE THE DEFECT, THE WSSC
- 22 MAY DECLARE THE CONTRACT TO BE VOID, AND THE CONTRACTOR IS:
- 23 1. ENTITLED TO THE REASONABLE VALUE OF WORK THAT
- 24 HAS BEEN PERFORMED AND MATERIALS THAT HAVE BEEN PROVIDED; AND
- 25 2. LIABLE TO THE WSSC FOR ANY COST INCURRED BY THE
- 26 WSSC IN COMPLETING THE WORK IN EXCESS OF THE UNPAID BALANCE OF THE
- 27 CONTRACT PRICE.
- 28 (III) IF THE CONTRACTOR CURES THE DEFECT, THE CONTRACT
- 29 REMAINS IN FORCE ACCORDING TO ITS REVISED TERMS.
- 30 (3) IF A CONTRACTOR WILLFULLY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE
- 31 REOUIREMENTS OF THE NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE AND THE CONTRACT IS
- 32 PARTLY EXECUTORY, THE WSSC MAY COMPEL THE CONTRACTOR TO CONTINUE TO
- 33 PERFORM UNDER THE CONTRACT, BUT THE WSSC:
- 34 (I) IS LIABLE FOR NO MORE THAN THE REASONABLE VALUE OF
- 35 WORK PERFORMED AND MATERIALS PROVIDED AFTER THE DATE ON WHICH THE
- 36 BREACH OF CONTRACT WAS OR SHOULD HAVE BEEN DISCOVERED; AND

- 1 (II) SHALL DEDUCT ANY MONEY THAT HAS BEEN PAID UNDER THE
- 2 CONTRACT FROM THE MONEY THAT COMES DUE UNDER ITEM (I) OF THIS
- 3 PARAGRAPH.
- 4 (4) IF A SUBCONTRACTOR WILLFULLY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE
- 5 REQUIREMENTS OF A NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE, THE CONTRACTOR MAY
- 6 DECLARE THE SUBCONTRACT TO BE VOID. IN THAT EVENT, THE CONTRACTOR IS
- 7 LIABLE FOR NO MORE THAN THE REASONABLE VALUE OF WORK PERFORMED OR
- 8 MATERIALS PROVIDED.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 10 October 1, 2000.
