- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a county board of education that meets in executive
- 4 session to provide timely public notice of the meeting; requiring a county board
- 5 that meets in executive session to reconvene in public session after the meeting

- 7 certain matters during the executive session; excluding certain actions taken in
