- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study the Maryland Agricultural
- 5 Land Preservation Foundation; specifying the membership and duties of the
- 6 Task Force; providing for the appointment of a chairman of the Task Force;
- 7 prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation;
- 8 authorizing a member of the Task Force to receive reimbursement for certain
- 9 expenses; providing for meetings of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to
- report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before certain dates;
- providing for staffing of the Task Force; providing for the termination of this Act;
- and generally relating to the Task Force to Study the Maryland Agricultural

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 Article Agriculture
- 22 2-517.
- 23 (A) THERE IS A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND 24 PRESERVATION FOUNDATION.
- 25 (B) THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 14 MEMBERS:
- 26 (1) ONE MEMBER FROM THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES TO BE APPOINTED 27 BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

- 1 ONE MEMBER FROM THE SENATE OF MARYLAND TO BE APPOINTED (2)2 BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE; THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL 4 LAND PRESERVATION FOUNDATION; 5 (4) THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE; THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, OR THE (5) 6 7 SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE: THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PLANNING, OR THE DIRECTOR'S 8 (6) 9 DESIGNEE: AND 10 EIGHT MEMBERS TO BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, AS (7) 11 FOLLOWS: 12 (I) ONE MEMBER FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE 13 MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION FOUNDATION; 14 ONE MEMBER FROM THE MARYLAND FARM BUREAU; (II)15 ONE MEMBER FROM THE AMERICAN FARMLAND TRUST; (III)16 (IV) ONE MEMBER REPRESENTING CONSERVATION GROUPS IN THE 17 STATE; ONE MEMBER FROM THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF 18 (V) 19 COUNTIES; 20 (VI) ONE MEMBER REPRESENTING A COUNTY AGRICULTURAL LAND 21 PRESERVATION PROGRAM; 22 (VII) ONE MEMBER FROM THE MARYLAND GRANGE; AND (VIII) ONE MEMBER FROM THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL 23 24 COMMISSION. THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE. 25 (C) A MEMBER OF THE TASK FORCE MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR 26
- 27 SERVING ON THE TASK FORCE, BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR
- 28 EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN
- 29 THE STATE BUDGET.
- THE TASK FORCE SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH AT THE CALL OF 30 (E) 31 THE CHAIRMAN.
- 32 (F) THE TASK FORCE SHALL:

- 1 (1) STUDY THE CURRENT PROGRAM AND PRACTICES OF THE MARYLAND 2 AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION FOUNDATION:
- 3 (2) STUDY THE FINANCIAL STANDING OF THE MARYLAND
- 4 AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION FOUNDATION; AND
- 5 (3) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE THE PROGRAM, PRACTICES,
- 6 AND FINANCIAL STANDING OF THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND
- 7 PRESERVATION FOUNDATION.
- 8 (G) THE TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT AN INTERIM REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS
- 9 AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE
- 10 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ON OR BEFORE
- 11 DECEMBER 1, 2000, AND SUBMIT A FINAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE
- 12 GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE JULY 31, 2001.
- 13 (H) THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE SHALL COORDINATE WITH OTHER
- 14 STATE AGENCIES TO PROVIDE STAFFING FOR THE TASK FORCE.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 July 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the
- 17 end of July 31, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
- 18 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
