3 FOR the purpose of establishing that a member of the Board of Trustees of
4 Chesapeake College may not serve for more than a certain number of terms;
5 providing that certain terms do not count toward the term limit; ~~providing for~~
6 ~~the termination of the terms of office of certain members of the Board on certain~~
7 ~~dates~~ conforming the time periods of the terms of certain members to the time
8 periods of the terms of certain other members; and generally relating to a term
9 limit for members of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Education**

18 16-406.

19 (a) (1) The Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College consists of two
20 members from each county that supports Chesapeake College who shall be appointed
21 by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the House of Delegates.

1 (2) The county superintendents of schools in the region are not ex officio
2 members.

3 (b) (1) Each member serves for a term of 4 years.

4 (2) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A
5 MEMBER APPOINTED TO BEGIN A TERM ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2000, MAY NOT SERVE
6 FOR MORE THAN THREE 4-YEAR TERMS.

7 (II) A TERM OF A MEMBER THAT BEGAN BEFORE JULY 1, 2000, DOES
8 NOT COUNT TOWARD THE TERM LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS
9 PARAGRAPH.

10 (c) Each member of the Board:

11 (1) Serves without compensation; and

12 (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with
13 applicable travel regulations.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That ~~on July 1, 2000, the~~
15 ~~terms of office of the incumbent members of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake~~
16 ~~College who have served the longest amount of time from each county that supports~~
17 ~~the college shall terminate.~~

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That ~~on July 1, 2002, the~~
19 ~~terms of office of the incumbent members of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake~~
20 ~~College who had served the shortest amount of time as of July 1, 2000, from each~~
21 ~~county that supports the college, or the members' replacement, shall terminate the~~
22 ~~term of office for an incumbent member of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake~~
23 ~~College representing Dorchester County that is due to expire in 2001 shall expire on~~
24 ~~July 1, 2002.~~

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the term of office for an
26 incumbent member of the Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College representing
27 Dorchester County that is due to expire in 2003 shall expire on July 1, 2004.

28 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
29 July 1, 2000.
