## Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore County - Reisterstown Elementary Police Athletic League/Recreation Center

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed $\$ 600,000$
$5 \$ \$ 500,000 \$ 575,000$, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Council and 6 the County Executive for Baltimore County for certain development or 7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject 8 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and 9 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:

12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
14 County - Reisterstown Elementary Police Athletic League/Recreation Center Loan of
152000 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) $\$ 600,000 \$ 500,000 \$ 575,000$

1 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5)
