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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County School Board Composition Task Force**  
3 **MC 15-00**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Montgomery County School Board Composition  
5 Task Force to study the authority, size, composition, and responsibilities of a  
6 certain school board; providing for the membership and the chair of the Task  
7 Force; providing for a quorum and the time and location of meetings of the Task  
8 Force; requiring the Task Force to submit a certain report by a certain date;  
9 providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the  
10 establishment of the Montgomery County School Board Composition Task Force.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Education**

19 3-904.

20 (A) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL ESTABLISH A  
21 MONTGOMERY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD COMPOSITION TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE  
22 AUTHORITY, SIZE, COMPOSITION, AND THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MONTGOMERY  
23 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

24 (B) (1) THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF 16 MEMBERS.

25 (2) THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE SHALL APPOINT TWO MEMBERS  
26 FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY SENATE DELEGATION.

1           (3)     THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE SHALL APPOINT TWO MEMBERS FROM  
2 THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY HOUSE DELEGATION.

3           (4)     THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL APPOINT:

4                   (I)     TWO MEMBERS FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL;

5                   (II)    TWO MEMBERS FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF  
6 EDUCATION;

7                   (III)   ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EDUCATION  
8 ASSOCIATION;

9                   (IV)   ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL OF  
10 SUPPORTING SERVICES EMPLOYEES;

11                   (V)     ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY ASSOCIATION  
12 OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL;

13                   (VI)    ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY REGIONAL  
14 STUDENT GOVERNMENTS;

15                   (VII)   ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL OF  
16 PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATIONS; AND

17                   (VIII)  THREE MEMBERS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

18    (C)     THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL SELECT THE CHAIR OF  
19 THE TASK FORCE.

20    (D)    (1)     TEN MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.

21           (2)     THE TASK FORCE SHALL DETERMINE THE TIME AND PLACE OF ITS  
22 MEETINGS.

23    (E)     ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2001, THE TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT A  
24 FINAL REPORT WITH ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE MONTGOMERY  
25 COUNTY EXECUTIVE, THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL, THE MONTGOMERY  
26 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE  
27 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY DELEGATIONS TO THE STATE  
28 SENATE AND HOUSE OF DELEGATES.

29    SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
30 July 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June  
31 30, 2002, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be  
32 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
