16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 (A) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL ESTABLISH A 21 MONTGOMERY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD COMPOSITION TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE

1 AUTHORITY, SIZE, COMPOSITION, AND THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE MONTGOMERY 2 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.
3 (B) (1) THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF 16 MEMBERS.
4 (2) THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE SHALL APPOINT TWO MEMBERS5 FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY SENATE DELEGATION.
6 (3) THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE SHALL APPOINT TWO MEMBERS FROM 7 THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY HOUSE DELEGATION.
8 (4) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL APPOINT:
9 (I) TWO MEMBERS FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL;
10 (II) TWO MEMBERS FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF 11 EDUCATION;
12 (III) ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EDUCATION 13 ASSOCIATION;
14(IV)ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL OF15SUPPORTING SERVICES EMPLOYEES;
16(V)ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY ASSOCIATION17OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL;
18 (VI) ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY REGIONAL 19 STUDENT GOVERNMENTS;
20 (VII) ONE MEMBER FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL OF 21 PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATIONS; AND
22 (VIII) THREE MEMBERS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
23 (C) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL SELECT THE CHAIR OF 24 THE TASK FORCE.
25 (D) (1) TEN MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.
26(2)THE TASK FORCE SHALL DETERMINE THE TIME AND PLACE OF ITS27 MEETINGS.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 1
