1 AN ACT concerning

Financial Institutions - Automated Teller Machines - Limitation on Fees

3 FOR the purpose of limiting the amount of the fee an operator of an automated teller

- 4 machine may charge for use of the automated teller machine by persons using
- 5 access devices not issued by the operator; and generally relating to fees for use of
- 6 automated teller machines.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Financial Institutions

15 1-404.

16 (a) At or before the time a transaction is initiated, the operator of an

17 automated teller machine shall provide the person using the automated teller

18 machine with notice of the fee to be charged by the operator for use of the automated

19 teller machine by persons using access devices not issued by the operator.

20 (b) (1) The operator may give the notice required under subsection (a) of this 21 section by either:

22 (i) Posting in a conspicuous place on or near the automated teller 23 machine the amount of the fee; or

24 (ii) Listing the amount of the fee on the screen of the automated 25 teller machine at the time the transaction is initiated.

1 (2) If the operator gives the notice in the manner provided by paragraph 2 (1)(ii) of this subsection, the person using the automated teller machine shall be 3 provided with the opportunity to cancel the transaction without incurring any fee.

4 (C) THE FEE CHARGED BY THE OPERATOR OF AN AUTOMATED TELLER
5 MACHINE FOR USE OF THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE BY PERSONS USING
6 ACCESS DEVICES NOT ISSUED BY THE OPERATOR MAY NOT EXCEED:

7 (1) \$1.00 PER TRANSACTION BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2000 THROUGH 8 SEPTEMBER 30, 2001;

9 (2) 75 CENTS PER TRANSACTION BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2001 THROUGH 10 SEPTEMBER 30, 2002; AND

11 (3) 50 CENTS PER TRANSACTION BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2002.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2000.
