EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN §§ 645JA THROUGH 645JG OF THIS ARTICLE, THE 19 20 COURT RETAINS REVISORY POWER AND CONTROL OVER A SENTENCE: 21 FOR A CRIME OF VIOLENCE AS DEFINED IN § 643B(A) OF THIS (1) 22 ARTICLE, REGARDLESS OF THE AMOUNT OF TIME SINCE THE IMPOSITION OF 23 SENTENCE: 24 (I) WHEN FRAUD, MISTAKE, OR IRREGULARITY HAVE OCCURRED; 25 OR

TO CORRECT AN ILLEGAL SENTENCE; AND

- 1 (2) FOR ALL OTHER CRIMES, WITHIN 1 YEAR OF THE IMPOSITION OF 2 SENTENCE.
- 3 (B) THE COURT SHALL MODIFY, REDUCE, CORRECT, OR VACATE A SENTENCE 4 ON THE RECORD, AFTER NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR EACH 5 TO BE HEARD.
- 6 (C) A PARTY TO A CRIMINAL PROCEEDING IN WHICH THE COURT MODIFIED,
 7 REDUCED, CORRECTED, OR VACATED A SENTENCE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION MAY
 8 FILE AN APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAL TO THE COURT OF SPECIAL APPEALS.
- 9 (D) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT THE COURT 10 FROM REVOKING THE SUSPENSION OF A SENTENCE OR PROBATION.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2000.
