- 3 (a) Except as provided by this section, a prosecution for a misdemeanor shall 4 be instituted within 1 year after the offense was committed.
- 5 (Y) A PROSECUTION FOR A VIOLATION OF THE WATER POLLUTION
- 6 PROVISIONS OF TITLE 49, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE SHALL BE
- 7 INSTITUTED WITHIN 2 YEARS AFTER THE OFFENSE WAS COMMITTED.
