1 AN ACT concerning

2 Nursing Homes - Increased Hourly Wage for Certified Nursing Assistants

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to
- 4 improve working conditions and increase retention of certain nursing home
- 5 personnel by increasing salary levels; authorizing the Department to adopt
- 6 certain regulations; and generally relating to staffing for nursing homes.

- 11 (1996 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Health General
- 15 19-1410.
- 16 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TAKE AFFIRMATIVE ACTION TO IMPROVE
- 17 WORKING CONDITIONS AND INCREASE RETENTION OF NURSING HOME DIRECT CARE
- 18 PERSONNEL.
- 19 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MODIFY THE DEPARTMENT MEDICAID
- 20 REIMBURSEMENT METHODOLOGY TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL MEDICAID FUNDS FOR
- 21 DIRECT REIMBURSEMENT TO NURSING HOMES TO INCREASE THE HOURLY WAGE OF
- 22 CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANTS A MINIMUM OF \$2 PER HOUR.
- 23 (C) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT THE REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY
- 24 OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2000.
