CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 World War II Memorial Fund

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include a certain amount in the State
- budget of a certain fiscal year to the Department of Veterans Affairs, to be
- 5 donated by the Department to the World War II Memorial Fund; and generally
- 6 relating to the World War II Memorial Fund.

7 Preamble

- 8 WHEREAS, Currently, there exists no national memorial dedicated to those
- 9 United States citizens who served during World War II; and
- WHEREAS, Sixteen million people served in the Armed Forces of the U.S.
- 11 during World War II, including 250,000 residents of Maryland; and
- 12 WHEREAS, 406,000 Americans died fighting for their country during World
- 13 War II, including 6,493 residents of Maryland; and

- WHEREAS, The citizens of the United States contributed and sacrificed as a 2 nation to support the troops abroad; and
- WHEREAS, A national World War II Memorial Fund has been established to
- 4 raise money for the construction of the first World War II Memorial in the United
- 5 States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The citizens of Maryland will have a unique opportunity to enjoy
- 7 the benefits of the Memorial, due to the close proximity of its future location,
- 8 Washington, D.C.; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The citizens of all states deserve to create a lasting reminder of
- 10 friends and family members who gave their lives in World War II so that future
- 11 generations might be free; now, therefore,
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Governor shall appropriate \$250,000 in the State budget for
- 14 fiscal year 2001 to the Department of Veterans Affairs. The Department shall donate
- 15 the appropriation to the World War II Memorial Fund located at 2300 Clarendon
- 16 Boulevard, Suite 501, Arlington, Virginia, 22201.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 18 July 1, 2000.
