FOR the purpose of requiring payment to a property owner from the court within a prescribed time in a "quick-take" condemnation proceedings; and generally relating to a certain payment from a court to a property owner in a "quick-take" condemnation proceedings.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Transportation Section 8-323(b) and 8-337 Annotated Code of Maryland (1993 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)
2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
