5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Prince George's Regional Association of Student
6 Governments to establish procedures for the election of the student member of
7 the Prince George's County Board of Education; and making those procedures
8 subject to the approval of the elected members of the Prince George's County
9 Board of Education.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

3 (f) (1) The student member shall be an eleventh or twelfth grade student in
4 the Prince George's County public school system during the student's term in office.

5 (2) An eligible student shall file a nomination form at least 2 weeks
6 before a special election meeting of the Prince George's regional association of student
7 governments. Nomination forms shall be made available in the administrative offices
8 of all public senior high schools in the County, the office of student concerns, and the
9 office of the president of the regional association. The delegates to the regional
10 association annually shall elect the student member to the Board at a special election
11 meeting to be held each school year.

12 (6) THE PRINCE GEORGE'S REGIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STUDENT
13 GOVERNMENTS MAY ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR THE ELECTION OF THE STUDENT
14 MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

15 (7) THE ELECTION PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE PRINCE
16 GEORGE'S REGIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STUDENT GOVERNMENTS ARE SUBJECT TO
17 THE APPROVAL OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 July 1, 2000.
