- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 14 70F.
- 15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A LIVE ELEPHANT USED IN A CARNIVAL,
- 16 CIRCUS, FAIR, CONTEST, PROMOTION, OR IN SIMILAR PUBLIC OR PRIVATE
- 17 ENTERTAINMENT.
- 18 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT USE A LIVE ELEPHANT FOR ENTERTAINMENT
- 19 PURPOSES WITHIN THE STATE.
- 20 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF
- 21 A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
- 22 \$2,500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2000.
