A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Sale or Transfer**
3 **PG 305-00**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Prince George's County Board of License
5 Commissioners from approving the issuance or transfer of a license into or
6 within the boundaries of a certain alcoholic beverages district; and generally
7 relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 9-217.

22 (l) (1) The Board of License Commissioners may not issue any new beer,
23 wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege within, or transfer any
24 additional beer, wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege into the
25 boundaries of the 13th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, or 27th alcoholic beverages
26 district:

1 (v) The 24th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
2 coterminous with the 24th legislative district of Prince George's County, as
3 determined by the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of
4 April 7, 1994, the alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

- 5 1. Election district 2, precincts 1, 2, and 7;
- 6 2. Election district 6, precinct 3;
- 7 3. Election district 13, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 14, 15, and 16;
- 8 4. Election district 17, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, and 8;
- 9 5. Election district 18, precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, and 9; and
- 10 6. Election district 20, precincts 4 and 8.

11 (2) (I) The Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners
12 may approve the issuance or transfer of a license into the boundaries of the 13th (that
13 portion located within the County), 21st, 22nd, 23rd, [24th,] 25th, 26th, or 27th
14 alcoholic beverages district provided any off-sale privileges of the license are
15 permanently waived as long as the license remains within the boundaries of the
16 district.

17 (II) THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE
18 COMMISSIONERS MAY NOT APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OR TRANSFER OF A LICENSE
19 INTO OR WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE 24TH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2000.
