1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - BLX License Requirements**  
3 **PG 316-00**

4 FOR the purpose of altering in Prince George's County the minimum capital  
5 investment for dining room facilities and kitchen equipment required in  
6 restaurants for which a Class BLX license is sought; and generally relating to  
7 Class BLX alcoholic beverages licenses issued in Prince George's County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 6-201(r)(1)(i), (r)(6)(i), and (r)(6)(iii)1.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 6-201.

22 (r) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

23 (6) (i) There is a Class BLX license, which is a special Class B license.

24 (iii) 1. Class BLX licenses may be issued only to luxury type  
25 restaurants, a term which shall be defined by the regulations of the Board.
