- 26 (1) the context clearly requires a different meaning; or
- 27 (2) a different definition is provided for a particular title or provision.

- 1 (D) "PROCUREMENT OFFICER" INCLUDES A PROCUREMENT OFFICER WHO 2 REPRESENTS A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.

- 4 (A) A PROCUREMENT OFFICER WHO IS NOT CERTIFIED AS A CERTIFIED
- 5 PROFESSIONAL PUBLIC BUYER (CPPB) BY THE COUNCIL WITHIN 2 YEARS FROM THE

- 14 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 15 on or application to any individual who was employed by the State or any political
- 16 subdivision of the State as a procurement officer before the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 18 October 1, 2000.
