**HOUSE BILL 1107** 1 HAVE HAD A GENERAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY ISSUED (1) 2 UNDER THIS TITLE WITHIN THE LAST 2 YEARS: COMPLETE THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS THAT 4 THE BOARD ESTABLISHES FOR A GENERAL LICENSE; AND PROVIDE DENTAL SERVICES AS REQUIRED UNDER § 4-308(C) OF THIS (3) 6 TITLE. 7 4-304.
