2 Anne Arundel County - State's Attorney - Salary 3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions of law regarding the salary of the State's Attorney for Anne Arundel County to increase the salary of the State's Attorney 4 5 to equal the salary of a circuit judge of certain judicial circuits as of the 6 beginning of a certain term of office; requiring the salary of the State's Attorney for Anne Arundel County to be increased annually by a certain amount; 7 8 providing for the application of this Act; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the salary of the State's Attorney of Anne Arundel 9 10 County. 11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

In Anne Arundel County: 20 (c) 21 (1) (i) [The State's Attorney's annual salary is: 1. 22 \$89,000 in calendar year 1998; 23 2. \$94,000 in calendar year 1999; 24 3. \$96,635 in calendar year 2000; 25 4. \$99,340 in calendar year 2001; and

- 1 5. \$102,125 in calendar year 2002]
- 2 1. THE STATE'S ATTORNEY'S SALARY SHALL BE EQUAL TO
- 3 THE SALARY OF A CIRCUIT JUDGE OF THE EIGHT JUDICIAL CIRCUITS AS OF THE
- 4 BEGINNING OF THE STATE'S ATTORNEY'S TERM OF OFFICE; AND
- 5 2. INCREASED ANNUALLY DURING THE TERM OF OFFICE BY
- 6 AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE INCREASE IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX DURING THE
- 7 PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 9 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 10 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Anne Arundel County
- 11 in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
- 12 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Anne Arundel County shall take
- 13 effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
- 14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 October 1, 2002.
