## A BILL ENTITLED

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of the Department of State Police to issue
- 4 identification cards to purchasers, renters, and transferors of regulated firearms
- 5 whose applications to purchase, rent, or transfer are not disapproved; specifying

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 17 (i) The Secretary may request the assistance of the Police Commissioner
- 18 of Baltimore City, the chief of police in any county maintaining a police force, or the
- 19 sheriff in a county not maintaining a police force and shall promptly upon receipt of
- 20 an application to purchase, rent, or transfer conduct an investigation in order to
- 21 determine the truth or falsity of the information supplied and statements made in the
- 22 application. If it be thereupon determined that any false information or statement has
- 23 been supplied or made by the applicant, that the application has not been properly
- 24 completed, or that written notification from the applicant's licensed attending
- 25 physician has been received stating that the applicant is suffering from a mental
- 26 disorder or disorders and is a danger to himself or herself or to others, the Secretary
- 27 shall notify the prospective seller, lessor, or transferor, in writing, within seven days
- 28 from the date the executed application to purchase or transfer was forwarded by
- 29 certified mail or facsimile machine, of his disapproval of the application. Written
- 30 notification of such disapproval shall be thereafter forwarded by the Secretary to the

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- 1 prospective purchaser, lessee, or transferee. The date upon which the executed
- 2 application to purchase, rent, or transfer was forwarded by certified mail or by
- 3 facsimile machine to the Secretary by the prospective seller, lessor, or transferor shall
- 4 be considered as the first day of the seven-day period allowed for notice of
- 5 disapproval to the prospective seller, lessor, or transferor. If the seventh day of the
- 6 seven-day period allowed for the notice of disapproval shall fall on a Sunday or legal
- 7 holiday, the computation period shall be extended to the first day next following,
- 8 which is neither a Sunday nor a legal holiday.
- 9 (2) (I) THE SECRETARY SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT 10 WHOSE APPLICATION IS NOT DISAPPROVED.

- 20 C. A DESCRIPTION OF THE LICENSE HOLDER, WHICH SHALL
- 21 INCLUDE THE HEIGHT, WEIGHT, AND SEX OF THE LICENSEE;
- 22 D. THE SIGNATURE AND SEAL OF THE ISSUING AGENT;
- 23 E. A SPACE FOR THE SIGNATURE OF THE LICENSE HOLDER;
- 24 AND
- 25 F. A FRONTAL PHOTOGRAPH OF THE LICENSE HOLDER.
- 26 (IV) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT
- 27 THIS PARAGRAPH, INCLUDING A REQUIREMENT FOR A SAFETY COURSE.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 October 1, 2000.
