2 Cemeteries - Veterans Organizations - Removable Decals on Headstones

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain veterans organizations to affix certain decals
- 4 to the headstones of deceased veterans; requiring the veterans organizations to
- 5 make reasonable efforts to locate the owner of the burial space prior to affixing
- 6 the decal; prohibiting a criminal penalty or civil liability to be levied against a
- 7 member of a veterans organization or a veterans organization for certain
- 8 actions; and generally relating to the placement of removable decals on the
- 9 headstones of deceased veterans by veterans organizations.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Business Regulation
- 23 5-803.
- 24 (A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, A VETERANS
- 25 ORGANIZATION DESIGNATED IN § 9-907(A)(2)(IV) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
- 26 ARTICLE MAY AFFIX UPON THE HEADSTONE OF A DECEASED VETERAN A
- 27 REMOVABLE DECAL THAT IDENTIFIES THE DECEASED VETERAN AS A MEMBER OF
- 28 THAT VETERANS ORGANIZATION.

- 1 (B) (1) A VETERANS ORGANIZATION SHALL MAKE A REASONABLE EFFORT
- 2 TO LOCATE THE OWNER OF THE BURIAL SPACE AND TO OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM
- 3 THE OWNER FOR THE PLACEMENT OF THE DECAL PRIOR TO AFFIXING THE DECAL
- 4 UPON THE HEADSTONE.
- 5 (2) (I) THE VETERANS ORGANIZATION SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS OF
- 6 ALL ATTEMPTS TO LOCATE THE OWNER OF THE BURIAL SPACE.
- 7 (II) IF THE OWNER OF THE BURIAL SPACE IS LOCATED, THE
- 8 VETERANS ORGANIZATION SHALL OBTAIN WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE
- 9 OWNER TO AFFIX THE DECAL TO THE HEADSTONE PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF THE
- 10 DECAL.
- 11 (III) IF THE OWNER OF THE BURIAL SPACE IS NOT LOCATED WITHIN
- 12 180 DAYS OF THE FIRST DOCUMENTED ATTEMPT TO LOCATE THE OWNER, THE
- 13 VETERANS ORGANIZATION MAY AFFIX THE DECAL TO THE HEADSTONE WITH NO
- 14 FURTHER ATTEMPT TO LOCATE THE OWNER OF THE BURIAL SITE.
- 15 (C) A MEMBER OF A VETERANS ORGANIZATION OR A VETERANS
- 16 ORGANIZATION MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL PENALTIES OR CIVIL LIABILITY
- 17 FOR ANY ACTION PERMITTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 20 (a) Any person who wilfully destroys, mutilates, defaces, injures, or removes
- 21 any tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure placed in any cemetery, or any
- 22 building, wall, fence, railing, or other work, for the use, protection, or ornamentation
- 23 of any cemetery in this State is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more
- 24 than \$5,000, or imprisoned for not more than 3 years, or both.
- 25 (b) Any person who wilfully destroys, cuts, breaks, or removes any tree, plant,
- 26 or shrub in any cemetery in this State, or who is found guilty of indecent or disorderly
- 27 conduct within said limits, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined not
- 28 more than \$500, or imprisoned for not more than 2 years, or both.
- 29 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the removal of the
- 30 remains of any human body, or of any monument, gravestone, or other marker from
- 31 an abandoned cemetery, provided that the prior consent in writing of the State's
- 32 Attorney of the county or of Baltimore City shall have been secured and provided
- 33 further that such remains, monuments, gravestone, or other marker is placed in an
- 34 accessible place in a permanent cemetery.
- 35 (D) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 5-803 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION
- 36 ARTICLE, VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS DESIGNATED IN § 9-907(A)(2)(IV) OF THE STATE
- 37 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE MAY AFFIX UPON THE HEADSTONE OF A DECEASED
- 38 VETERAN A REMOVABLE DECAL THAT IDENTIFIES THE DECEASED VETERAN AS A
- 39 MEMBER OF THAT VETERANS ORGANIZATION.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2000.
