HOUSE BILL 1173 1 STATES THE DURATION OF THE EXTENSION OF THE LICENSE (I) 2 REVOCATION, DATING FROM THE DATE OF THE CONVICTION VIOLATION, DURING 3 WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL'S LICENSE MAY NOT BE REINSTATED; AND (II)ADVISES THE INDIVIDUAL OF THE RIGHT TO REQUEST A 5 HEARING.
