A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program - Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum fee that the Motor Vehicle
4 Administration and the Secretary of the Environment may establish for vehicles
5 inspected and tested under the Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program; and
6 generally relating to the Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 23-205.

16 (a) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Administration and
17 the Secretary shall set the fee to be charged for each vehicle to be inspected and tested
18 by a facility.

19 (2) The fee established under this subsection[:

20 (i) During the period from January 1, 1995 through May 31, 1997,
21 may not exceed \$12; and

22 (ii) During the period after May 31, 1997,] may not exceed [\$14]
23 \$20.

24 (b) The fee shall be collected in a manner established by the Administration
25 and the Secretary.

1 (c) A specific portion of the fee shall be paid to or retained by the
2 Administration to cover the cost of administration and enforcement of the emissions
3 control program, as provided in the contract between the contractor and the State.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 July 1, 2000.
