## 2 Education - Rebate to Counties for New Teacher Settlement Costs

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to provide a rebate
- 4 to counties for certain settlement costs the county incurs for the benefit of new
- 5 teachers, subject to certain limitations; requiring each county to maintain
- 6 certain records and to submit the records to the Department by a certain date
- 7 each year; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to State
- 8 rebates to counties for new teacher settlement costs.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Education

17 6-114.

- 18 (A) IF A COUNTY ESTABLISHES A PROGRAM UNDER WHICH THE COUNTY PAYS
- 19 SETTLEMENT COSTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF A NEW TEACHER, THE DEPARTMENT
- 20 SHALL PROVIDE A REBATE TO THE COUNTY FOR THE SETTLEMENT COSTS THAT THE
- 21 COUNTY INCURS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE NEW TEACHER, SUBJECT TO THE
- 22 FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:
- 23 (1) THE COSTS SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE COSTS OF SETTLEMENT FOR
- 24 RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY VALUED AT OR BELOW \$150,000; AND
- 25 (2) THE COSTS SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE TOTAL AMOUNT PAID TO THE
- 26 STATE OR A STATE AGENCY AT SETTLEMENT.
- 27 (B) (1) EACH COUNTY SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS OF ALL SETTLEMENT
- 28 COSTS THE COUNTY INCURS FOR THE BENEFIT OF NEW TEACHERS IN THE COUNTY.

- 1 (2) EACH COUNTY SHALL SUBMIT THE RECORDS TO THE DEPARTMENT 2 BY SEPTEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.
- 3 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF THE REBATE TO 4 EACH COUNTY AFTER REVIEW OF EACH COUNTY'S RECORD OF SETTLEMENT COSTS.
- 5 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO 6 IMPLEMENT THIS ACT.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 8 effect June 1, 2001.
