5 FOR the purpose of requiring that a question be placed on the ballot in Prince

- George's County at the November general election of 2000 to determine the 6
- 7 sense of the voters of the County on the issue of establishing a teachers' salary
- 8 equity program in the County that would make teachers' salaries in the County
- comparable to and competitive with the teachers' salaries paid in certain other 9
- public school districts; providing for the carrying out of the straw poll; and 10
- generally relating to the holding of a straw ballot in Prince George's County. 11

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 13 MARYLAND, That under the provisions of Article 33 Election Code of the
- 14 Annotated Code of Maryland, the Prince George's County Board of Elections, in
- 15 consultation with the State Board of Elections, shall prepare and include on the ballot
- 16 for the November general election of 2000 the following question:

17 "Prince George's County - Teachers' Salary Equity Program

- 18 Do you favor the establishment of a teachers' salary equity program in Prince
- 19 George's County that would make teachers' salaries in the Prince George's County
- 20 public schools comparable to and competitive with the salaries paid to teachers in the
- 21 other public school districts in the Washington, D.C. Baltimore, MD metropolitan
- 22 region?"

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Prince George's

- 24 County Board of Elections and the Prince George's County Council shall do those
- 25 things necessary and proper to place this question on the ballot prepared for the
- 26 November general election of 2000, so that each participating voter in the County
- 27 may have the opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall be
- 28 proposed, presented, tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of
- 29 Article 33 of the Annotated Code. The vote on this question is advisory only.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2000.
