A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Passenger Railroad Services - Bicycles - Transport**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Mass Transit Administration to permit a person to
4 transport a bicycle on passenger railroad services; providing certain
5 circumstances under which a person is not permitted to transport a bicycle on
6 passenger railroad services; defining a certain term; and generally relating to
7 the transport of bicycles on passenger railroad services.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Transportation**

16 7-902.

17 (C) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "BICYCLE" SHALL HAVE THE MEANING STATED
18 IN § 11-104 OF THIS ARTICLE.

19 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
20 ADMINISTRATION SHALL PERMIT A PERSON TO TRANSPORT A BICYCLE ON
21 PASSENGER RAILROAD SERVICES.

22 (3) A PERSON MAY NOT TRANSPORT A BICYCLE ON PASSENGER
23 RAILROAD SERVICES DURING:

- 24 (I) HOURS OF HIGH VOLUME PASSENGER TRAFFIC;
- 25 (II) A LEGAL HOLIDAY; OR
- 26 (III) A MAJOR SCHEDULED SPORTING EVENT.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2000.
