

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each board of community college trustees in the State to

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 16-103.
- 17 (a) In addition to the other powers granted and duties imposed by this title,
- 18 and subject to the authority of the Maryland Higher Education Commission, each
- 19 board of community college trustees has the powers and duties set forth in this
- 20 section.
- 21 (b) With the approval of the Maryland Higher Education Commission, each
- 22 board of trustees may establish and operate one or more community colleges.
- 23 (c) Each board of trustees shall exercise general control over the community
- 24 college, keep separate records and minutes, and adopt reasonable rules, regulations,
- 25 or bylaws to carry out the provisions of this subtitle.
- 26 (d) Each board of trustees may fix the salaries and tenure of the president,
- 27 faculty, and other employees of the community college.



- 1 (n) Each board of trustees may adopt a corporate seal.
- 2 $\,$ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3 $\,$ July 1, 2000.
