1 AN ACT concerning

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## Town of Oakland, Garrett County - Participation by Employees in Employees' Pension System

4 FOR the purpose of making it mandatory, and not optional, for certain employees of

- 5 the Town of Oakland, Garrett County to participate in the Employees' Pension
- 6 System of the State of Maryland as of a certain date; providing for certain
- 7 employees of the Town of Oakland to receive service credit for certain prior
- 8 service, except for an employee that becomes a member of the Employees'
- 9 Pension System after the effective date of participation in the Employees'
- 10 Pension System by the Town of Oakland; and generally relating to the
- 11 participation of certain employees of the Town of Oakland, Garrett County, in
- 12 the Employees' Pension System.

31 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section AND § 31-111.1 OF THIS

32 SUBTITLE, if an employee of a participating governmental unit joins the Employees'

33 Pension System within 1 year after the effective date, the employee is entitled to

34 service credit for employment with the participating governmental unit before the 35 effective date.

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1 (b) If an employee of the Baltimore Metropolitan Council elects to become a

2 member of the Employees' Retirement System or the Employees' Pension System, the

3 employee may not receive credit for service from July 1, 1992, to the effective date

4 unless the employee pays to the Board of Trustees the amount of the member

5 contributions the employee would have made during that period, plus regular6 interest.

8 (A) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND SHALL RECEIVE ONE-THIRD
9 OF THE SERVICE CREDIT FOR ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE SERVICE
10 PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE IN THE AMOUNT OF THE EMPLOYEE'S CREDIT, AS
11 CERTIFIED BY THE TOWN OF OAKLAND AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 (B) IF AN EMPLOYEE OR A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND
13 BECOMES A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM AT ANY TIME AFTER
14 THE EFFECTIVE DATE, THE EMPLOYEE MAY NOT RECEIVE SERVICE CREDIT FOR
15 EMPLOYMENT WITH THE TOWN OF OAKLAND BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 June 1, 2000.

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
