A BILL ENTITLED

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2 Health Care for the Uninsured

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include certain amounts in the budget
- 4 for a certain fiscal year for the Baltimore County Department of Health for use
- 5 by the PARTNERS Health Improvement Program and the Baltimore City
- 6 Health Department for use by the Men's Public Health Center.
- 7 Preamble
- 8 WHEREAS, One in seven Baltimore County residents, approximately 100,000
- 9 individuals, is uninsured;
- WHEREAS, The numbers of uninsured individuals are expected to grow
- 11 because fewer individuals have job-based health coverage than 10 years ago and by
- 12 the year 2005 it is estimated that 67% of jobs in the United States will be permanent
- 13 part-time with no health benefits;
- 14 WHEREAS, Uninsured individuals often delay seeking medical care, leading to
- 15 more expensive care, unpaid bills that raise insurance rates for the rest of the
- 16 population, loss of productivity, increased absence from work, and potential exposure
- 17 of diseases to coworkers;
- 18 WHEREAS, The Baltimore County Department of Health is overseeing the
- 19 development of the PARTNERS Health Improvement Program (PARTNERSH.I.P.),
- 20 which is a private-public partnership program providing comprehensive preventive
- 21 health coverage for uninsured Baltimore County families whose incomes fall below
- 22 200% of the federal poverty level;
- WHEREAS, The PARTNERSH.I.P. will enhance the overall health of the
- 24 community, restore and maintain the stability of working families, and reduce the
- 25 cost of health care to taxpayers, businesses, and health care providers;
- 26 WHEREAS, The PARTNERSH.I.P. requires State funding to cover copayments,
- 27 pharmaceuticals, rehabilitation equipment, and currently uncovered health services,
- 28 as well as to serve a larger portion of the uninsured population;

- WHEREAS, African American males between the ages of 19 and 64 are
- 2 disproportionately likely to be uninsured;
- WHEREAS, The Baltimore City Health Department has created the Men's
- 4 Public Health Center to provide access to health care to members of the male
- 5 population of Baltimore who are currently uninsured or under insured;
- 6 WHEREAS, The Men's Public Health Center will seek funding from private
- 7 foundations and will also require State funding for both capital and programmatic
- 8 costs: now, therefore,
- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 10 MARYLAND, That the Governor shall include in the fiscal year 2002 budget \$300,000
- 11 for the Baltimore County Department of Health for use in the PARTNERS Health
- 12 Improvement Program and \$200,000 to be used by the Baltimore City Health
- 13 Department for use in the Men's Public Health Initiative.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 October 1, 2000.
