1 (g) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the Department 2 may issue an apprenticeship permit for any activity under subsection (d)(2)(ii)1 or 2 of 3 this section to a person who currently resides and has resided for at least 5 years on 4 an island in the State that is at least 3 miles from the mainland.
