Preamble

18 WHEREAS, In accordance with Chapter 113 of the Acts of 1998, the Department

19 of Health and Mental Hygiene established by regulation a 5-year oral health care

20 plan that set utilization targets for managed care organizations and dental managed

21 care organizations under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program to measure22 demonstrated increases in access by program enrollees to dental services; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene has reported that no substantial progress has been made toward meeting the utilization targets; and

WHEREAS, The lack of access to dental care for Program enrollees is directly a result of inadequate reimbursement rates paid by the managed care organizations and dental managed care organizations; now, therefore,

28 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 29 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 6 7	(D) (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE BUDGET FOR THE DEPARTMENT SUFFICIENT FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM TO ASSURE THAT REIMBURSEMENT RATES PROVIDED TO DENTISTS BY MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS AND DENTAL MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS ARE SET AT A LEVEL THAT IS SUFFICIENT TO MEET THE UTILIZATION TARGETS FOR DENTAL SERVICES ESTABLISHED IN THE ORAL HEALTH CARE PLAN.
	(2) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2001, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE THAT EACH MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION AND DENTAL MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT FOR DENTAL FEES AS FOLLOWS:

21 intent of the General Assembly of Maryland that the Governor include in the annual
22 budget sufficient funds provided through the rate-setting process to support
23 managed care organizations in meeting the requirement of this Act.
