## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Kent County - Sea Duck Zones - Regulation

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of Natural Resources from adopting
- 4 certain regulations restricting the hunting of certain wild waterfowl during the
- 5 open season in a sea duck zone in Kent County; and generally relating to the
- 6 regulation of sea duck zones in Kent County.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 8 Article Natural Resources
- 9 Section 10-205
- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1990 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Natural Resources
- 15 10-205.
- 16 (a) (1) Having a due regard for the distribution, abundance, economic value,
- 17 and breeding habits of wildlife, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
- 18 SUBSECTION, the Secretary may adopt regulations to enlarge, extend, restrict, or
- 19 prohibit hunting, possessing, selling, purchasing, shipping, carrying, transporting, or
- 20 exporting wildlife.
- 21 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ADOPT REGULATIONS RESTRICTING IN
- 22 A SEA DUCK ZONE IN KENT COUNTY THE HUNTING OF ANY WILD WATERFOWL
- 23 OTHERWISE PERMITTED TO BE HUNTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE
- 24 DURING THE OPEN SEASON.
- 25 (b) In addition to any other penalty provided in this title, any person convicted
- 26 of violating any regulation adopted by the Department shall be fined \$5 for each bird,
- 27 mammal, amphibian, or reptile illegally hunted or possessed. However, this
- 28 additional penalty does not apply to game birds and mammals. If a person is

- 1 convicted a second or subsequent time within the same 12 month period for a 2 violation of the regulations the Department adopts, the person:
- 3 (1) Shall have the person's hunter's license suspended; and
- 4 (2) May not procure a hunter's license the following calendar year.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2000.
