SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10

11 MARYLAND, That:

12 There shall be a Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland (a) 13 consisting of the following members:

14 (1)Two members of the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, 15 appointed by the President of the Senate;

16 Two members of the House Ways and Means Committee, appointed (2)17 by the Speaker of the House;

18 (3) The Comptroller of the Treasury;

19 The Secretary of Business and Economic Development; (4)

- The Director of Assessments and Taxation; 20 (5)
- 21 (6)The Secretary of Budget and Management; and
- 22 (7)One member of the public, appointed by the Governor.
- 23 The Governor shall designate the Chairman of the Task Force. (b)

The Task Force shall review the current State and local tax credits 24 (c) (1)25 that are available to individuals and businesses that provide economic development 26 in Maryland.
