2 Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland
FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland; specifying the membership and duties of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to report to certain individuals on or before a certain date; requiring the Department of Business and Economic Development and the Comptroller's Office to provide certain support to the Task Force; providing for the termination of the Task Force; and generally relating to the establishment of a Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland.
10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:
12 (a) There shall be a Task Force to Study Business Tax Credits in Maryland 13 consisting of the following members:
14 (1) Two members One member of the Senate Budget and Taxation 15 Committee, appointed by the President of the Senate;
16 (2) Two members One member of the House Ways and Means Committee 17 Committee on Ways and Means, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
18 (3) The Comptroller of the Treasury;
19 (4) The Secretary of Business and Economic Development;
20 (5) The Director of Assessments and Taxation:

- (1) 28 The Department of Business and Economic Development; and
- 29 (2) The Comptroller of the Treasury.
- 30 The Task Force shall terminate, and this Act shall be null and void after
- 31 December 31, 2000 with no further action required by the General Assembly.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 June 1, 2000.
