A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Register - Synopses of Introduced Legislation**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that the Maryland Register contain a
4 synopsis of each bill that is introduced during each session of the General
5 Assembly.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Article - State Government
8 Section 7-206(a)
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1999 Replacement Volume)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Government**

14 7-206.

15 (a) An issue of the Register shall contain:

16 (1) on the first page:

17 (i) the closing date and hour of the issue; and

18 (ii) the issue date, which shall be the date of deposit in the United
19 States mail and shall appear prominently;

20 (2) the text of each of the following documents that has been submitted
21 to the Division before the closing date and hour and has not been published
22 previously:

23 (i) [during] FOR each session of the General Assembly[:

24 1. a synopsis of each bill that is introduced; and

1 (xiv) each other document that is required to be published in the
2 Register;

3 (xv) each notice or other document issued by an agency of a county
4 or municipal government that the Committee permits to be published in the Register;
5 and

6 (xvi) unless otherwise privileged, each other document that the
7 Committee permits to be published in the Register;

8 (3) a table of contents; and

9 (4) an index to each title of the Code of Maryland Regulations that a
10 document in the issue affects.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2000.
