28 (d) Any person or dealer who is a knowing participant in a straw purchase of 29 a regulated firearm to a prohibited person or to a minor, or transports regulated 30 firearms into this State for the purpose of illegal sale or trafficking of a regulated

- 1 firearm shall be guilty of a [misdemeanor] FELONY and upon conviction be fined not 2 more than \$25,000 or imprisoned for not more than 10 years, or both. Each violation
- 3 shall be considered a separate offense.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 2000.
