- 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 26 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SURPLUS OF GENERAL FUNDS" MEANS AN AMOUNT OF
- 27 UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUNDS IN A FISCAL YEAR THAT EXCEEDS \$25 MILLION,
- 28 AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE COMPTROLLER.

- 1 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW AND SUBJECT TO
- 2 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, IN THE SECOND FISCAL YEAR AFTER A FISCAL
- 3 YEAR IN WHICH THERE WAS A SURPLUS OF GENERAL FUNDS, THE GOVERNOR SHALL
- 4 APPROPRIATE TO THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO AT
