A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Law - Businesses and Associations - Federal Identification Number**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain businesses and associations to include a federal
4 identification number on an application for a certificate of title of a vehicle.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Transportation**

18 13-104.

19 (a) The application for a certificate of title of a vehicle shall be made by the
20 owner of the vehicle on the form that the Administration requires.

21 (c) The application shall contain:

22 (1) The full name and Maryland address of the owner, including:

23 (i) If the owner is an individual, the owner's Maryland residence
24 and mailing addresses;

1 (ii) If the owner is a business firm, association, or corporation, its
2 business address in this State or the name and address of a resident agent in this
3 State AND ITS FEDERAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER;

4 (iii) If the owner is a partnership or joint venture, the name of each
5 partner or joint venturer;

6 (iv) If the owner is an unincorporated association, joint stock
7 company, or other group described in § 6-406 of the Courts Article, the name and
8 address of a resident agent on whom service may be made in any law suit arising out
9 of the ownership, maintenance, or use of the vehicle; and

10 (v) If the owner is a trustee, the address of the trust in this State
11 and the name and address of a person in this State on whom service may be made in
12 any law suit arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of the vehicle;

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
14 effect October 1, 2000.
